

SUBJECT:	PRAYER REQUESTS FOR THE NATION OF KENYA IN A SERIOUS POLITICAL CRISIS
FOCUS:	A Call to Repentance, Cry for God's mercy, Intercede, stand in the Gap and Pray without ceasing until something happens in Kenya!
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In the midst of Kenyan political turmoil, our God is Almighty (Jehovah El-Shaddai) and Sovereign (Jehovah Adonai) and so we can run to HIM and HIS NAME alone. <i>"The name of the LORD is a strong tower, the righteous run to it and are safe". (Prov. 18:10).</i></li> <li>• Repentance for Kenya is needed: Amos 5:12 <i>"For I (God) know your many transgressions and your many sins".</i> God commands us to repent of our evil, <i>"Therefore this is what the LORD says: "If you repent, I will restore you that you may serve me" Jer. 15:19. "Repent! Turn away from all your offenses; then sin will not be your downfall ... Repent and live! Eze. 18:30-32.</i></li> <li>• Repent for Tribalism that has led to merciless killings and wanton destruction of property: <i>"For I take no pleasure in the death of anyone, declares the Sovereign LORD.</i></li> <li>• Repent for Bloodshed <i>The LORD hates and detests ... hands that shed innocent blood (Prov. 6:16,17).</i> Lets hate bloodshed, so that it will not pursue Kenyans (Hab. 2:12). God, keep <i>"Away from Kenya, the bloodthirsty men! (Prov. 139:19) and save the people (Psa. 59:2).</i></li> <li>• Repent for Bitterness and Anger that's making many to have <i>"Their mouths full of cursing and bitterness (Rom. 3:14).</i> Ask God to enable Kenyans and their leaders <i>"Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice and "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Not let any unwholesome talk come out of their mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen (Eph. 4: 29-32).</i></li> <li>• Repent for hardening of hearts through this testing period: <i>"Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as you did in the rebellion, during the time of testing in the desert" (Ex. 4:21, 10:20, Heb. 3:8, Psa. 95:8). "Blessed is the man who always fears the LORD, but he who hardens his heart falls into trouble (Prov. 28:14).</i> Pray for God's voice to be heard clearly!</li> <li>• Repent of pride among leaders and people of Kenya: <i>"I hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech. (Prov. 8:13); "Pride only breeds quarrels" (Prov. 13:10). "Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall (Prov. 16:18).</i> Pray against quarrels and destruction.</li> <li>• Let us cry for God's Mercy: <i>"Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need" (Heb. 4:16). " David said to Gad, "I am in deep distress. Let us fall into the hands of the LORD, for his mercy is great; but do not let me fall into the hands of men." 2 Sam. 24:14); "He who conceals his sins does not prosper, but whoever confesses and renounces them finds mercy (Prov. 28: 13).</i></li> <li>• Pray for cleansing of the land and people of Kenya with the blood of Jesus: <i>"wash away all our iniquity and cleanse us from our sin" (Psa. 51:2); "How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our</i></li> </ul>	

*consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!" (Heb. 9:14).*

- *Ask the Sovereign LORD to heal Kenya "If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land (2 Chro. 7:14). Pray against "Reckless words that pierce like a sword" and for God to send "wise and trustworthy envoys who bring healing (Prov. 12:18; 13:17); "The tongue that brings healing is a tree of life. (Prov. 15:4); Pray for those wounded and deceased: "He heals the broken-hearted and binds up their wounds"*
- *Pray for Jehovah Shalom (The Lord our peace) to grant peace and calm in the land (Lev. 26:6) God has called us to live in peace (1 Cor. 7:15) and be at peace with each other (Mk. 9:50).*
- *Pray for truth and justice to prevail: "The LORD (of Truth) loves righteousness and justice (Psa. 33:5; Isa. 61:8); The LORD detests lying lips, but he delights in men who are truthful (Prov. 12:22) Pray against those are lying, spreading false reports, following the crowd in doing wrong, that leaders will not pervert justice by siding with the crowd; no partiality and favouritism (Ex. 23:2; Lev. 19:15). By justice a king gives a country stability (Prov. 29:4); Blessed are they who maintain justice, who constantly do what is right (Psa. 106:3). Read Prov. 12: 17-22).*
